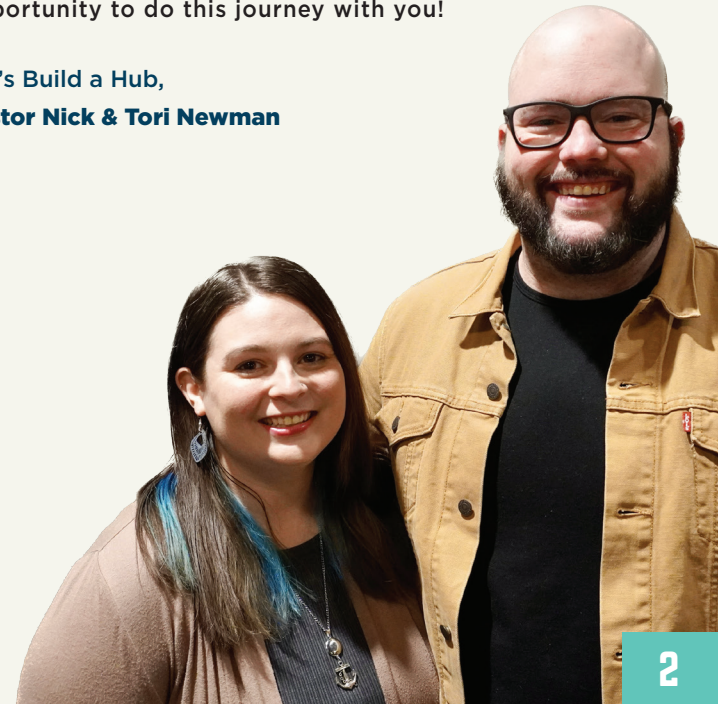

September 2015

Pastor Nick and Tori hosted the first Sunday gathering of Propel Church in Mount Pleasant High School.

September 2018

We made the jump to two Sunday worship experiences to create more space for people to meet Jesus.

December 2019

We transitioned from portable and started the build out of a permanent location in Mount Pleasant located at 400 N. Main Street.

March 2020

We began meeting weekly online and filmed our experiences at 400 N. Main Street during the pandemic.

December 2020

After many months of being online we were able to regather as a church to host in-person worship experiences.

September 2022

We closed on 6.88 acres of land in cash for \$325,000 and made MPMS our temporary home.

November 2022

An additional 1.18 acres of land was donated to bring our acreage total to 8.06.

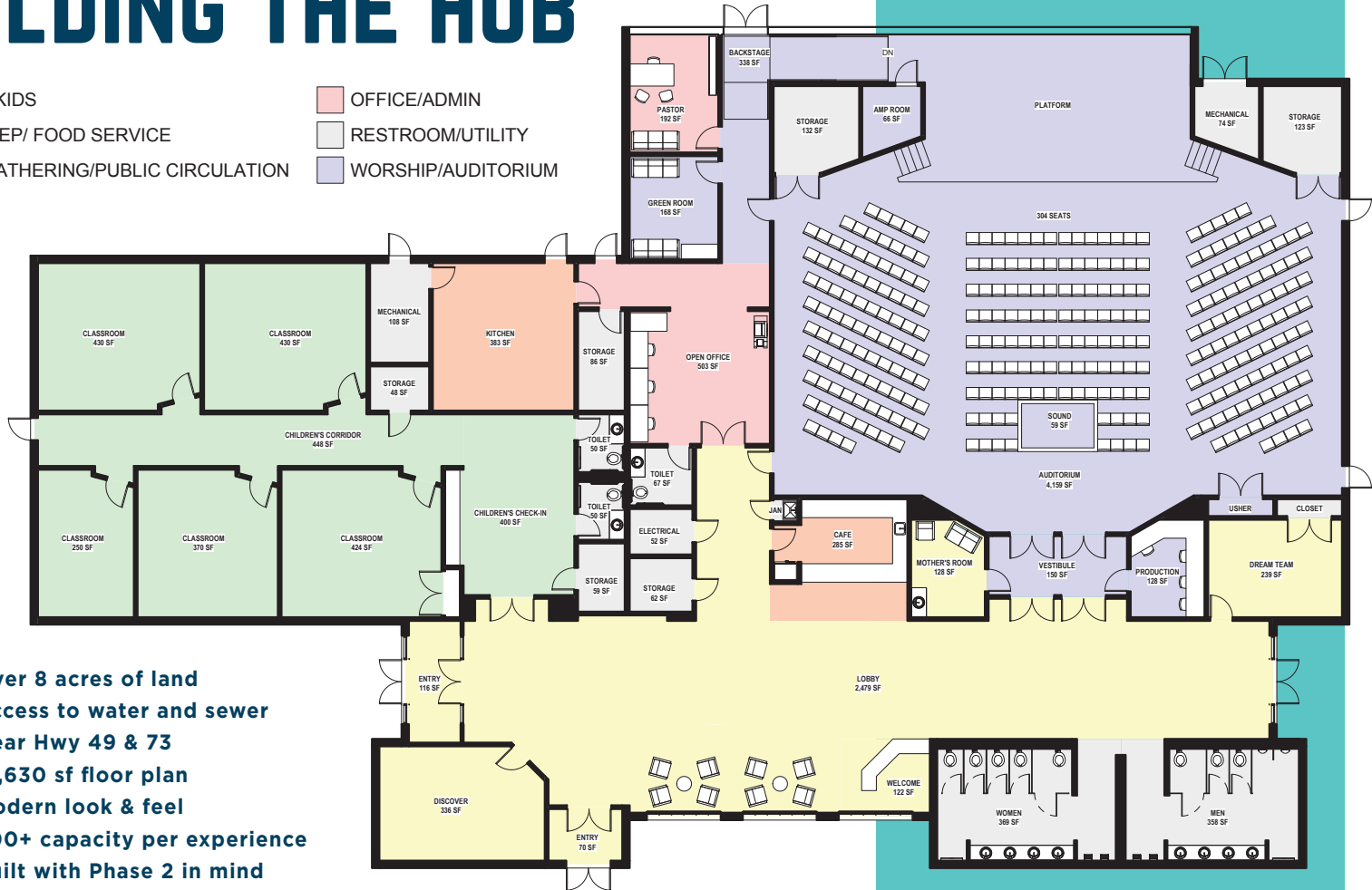

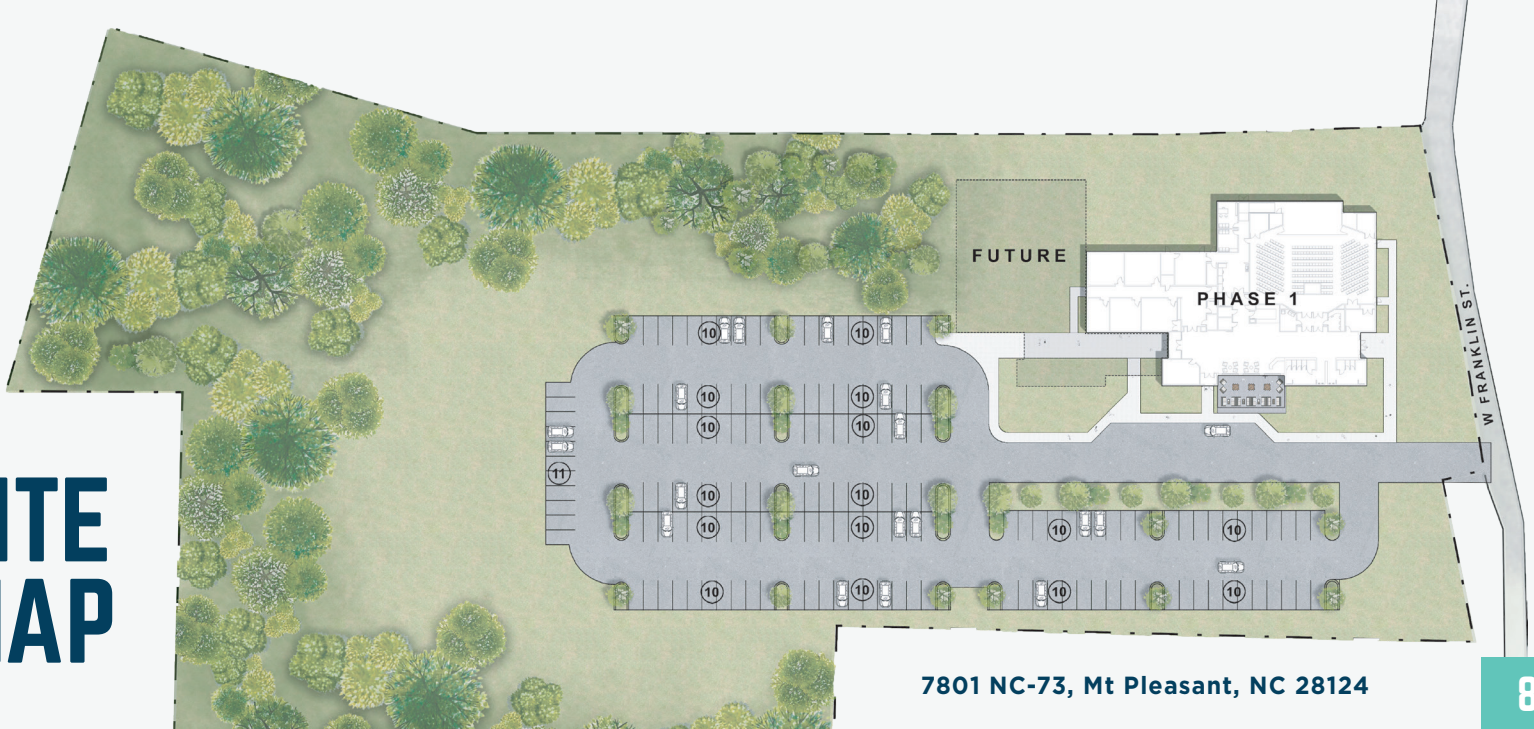

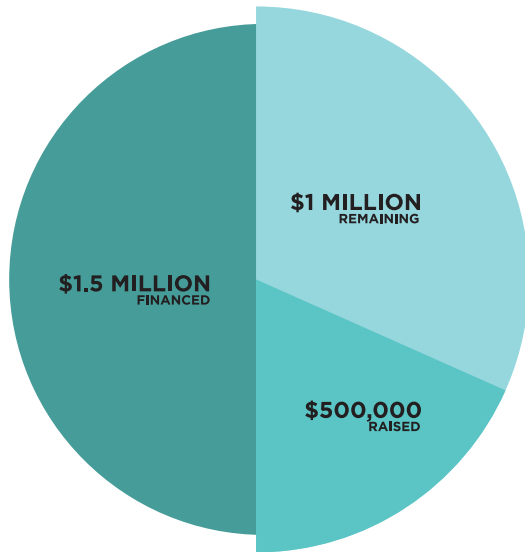

BIG GIVE GIFT:

Raising \$1,500,000 over the next two years will allow us to meet the minimum lending requirement needed to start our building project. Therefore, your generous BIG GIVE gifts will lay the foundation for our Build The Hub initiative and cover most of our efforts to break ground.

CREATIVE WAYS TO GIVE

There are many ways to participate in giving.
Here are a few to consider:

APPRECIATED ASSETS

Consider transferring appreciated assets like stocks, real estate, etc as a way to increase giving and fulfill your commitment.

SALE OF ASSETS

Donate money from the sale of personal or business assets.

SAVINGS & INVESTMENTS

You may be able to give some portion of your accumulated assets without significantly affecting your financial future security.

DELAYED EXPENDITURES

Choose to delay an anticipated purchase.

INCOME-PRODUCING ASSETS

Consider giving interest earned, income from rental properties, or funds from other income-producing assets.

INCOME & SACRIFICE

Consider pledging 10% of your annual income in addition to your regular financial support of Propel Church.

Ask God how He wants you to give as an individual or family.

LISTEN

Remain open to how He wants you to contribute to the growth of His Kingdom.

3
OBEY

Take a brave step of faith and follow through on His instructions to you.

4
WATCH

Prepare to see how God works through us for His will to be done.

GIVING PROCESS

- + Review the campaign information materials prayerfully.
- + Make a decision and commit to it. Determine in your heart to see your commitment through.
- + Fill out a Build the Hub commitment envelope in-person. Plan to turn it in, along with your initial BIG GIVE gift, on Sunday, March 19th.
- + We encourage you to set up a recurring donation for your Build The Hub commitment over the duration of the next 24 months.
- + Everyone who gives will receive a regular update on the project with financials, progress, and news.
- + You will not receive giving reminders, but you will receive letters of appreciation to celebrate milestones along the journey.



FAQ

What is the business plan for funding our new facility? We plan to utilize cash on hand, income from our funding initiative, and long term borrowing. When we reach our giving goal, upon completion of the building, Propel Church will have instant equity in the facility, making it an asset to the ministry.

Should I redirect my regular giving to Build the Hub? Giving to "Build The Hub" is a sacrificial gift above and beyond your regular giving. This additional support enables a growth initiative outside of Propel Church's regular operating budget. Regular giving goes to support the operating budget, which funds day-to-day ministry.

Is my giving tax-deductible? Yes, all donations to Propel Church are 100% tax-deductible.

What happens if I am unable to fulfill my commitment? Nothing. Who you are is way more important to us than what you do for the church. We want everyone to feel welcomed and valuable. Our greatest resource isn't financial, but rather the faithful family that God has brought to this church.
